**Housedean Farm**, Brighton Road, Lewes, BN7 3JW, Tel: 07919 668816. Open: April-October. Working farm with pitches for tents and small campervans as well as 2 bell tents (furnished or unfurnished that sleep up to 6 people each) a Shepherd Hut (sleeps up to 2 adults and 1 child) and a Camping Pod (2 x single beds). Showers, toilets, and washing up facilities. Firepits for campfires (logs, kindling, firelighters available to purchase) and bicycle hire. 2 night minimum on weekends or 3 night minimum on bank holiday weekends. Bus no 28 or 29 bus from Brighton city centre stops outside the campsite/ farm. [www.housedean.co.uk](http://www.housedean.co.uk).

Tents only. Each pitch with its own fire pit, large communal marquee for shelter from rain or sun, children's activities some Sundays, pubs, tea room, coffee shop and grocer nearby.
